Case Summary:

Rule 10 incident on the top mark.

Procedural Matters:

ARG 219355 did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).

Facts Found:

1. 10 Knots.
2. URU 216144 on starboard tack and ARG 219355 on port tack were approaching the first upwind mark on converging course.
3. When they were at 1 metre distance they were aiming bow to bow.
4. URU 216144 bore away sharply and past astern of ARG 219355.
5. ARG 219355 made one turn and continued sailing.

Conclusion & Rules:

1. ARG 219355 on port failed to keep clear of URU 216144 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
2. By not completely taking the Two-turns Penalty, ARG 219355 failed to comply with the requirements of RRS 44.2.
