Case Summary:

Procedural Matters:

Facts Found:

1. SI 2.1 states that competitors while racing shall use BIBs in accordance to their ranking.
2. PER 217115 was assigned a BIB for Monday 20th races.
3. During race 5 PER 217115 sailed using the BIB as per SI 2.1
4. PER 217115 changed clothes between race 5 and 6.
5. During race 6 and 7 PER 217115 sailed without using the BIB.
6. PER 217115 did not notified the RC, TC or Jury about not having a BIB.
7. SI 2.1 is DP

Conclusion & Rules:

1. By not wearing the BIB, PER 217115 infringed SI 2.1 in race 6 and 7.

Decision:

1. Using the Discretionary Penalty Policy, a starting penalty of 5% was decided (Band 1).

2. The penalty was decreased because the sailor appoligized and didn't intended to achieve an advantage by the infrigment.

3. PER 217115 is penalized 2,5% applied to race 6 and 7, calculated to the nearest tenth of a point, (0.05 to be rounded upward), but not worse than the score for DNF.
