Procedural Matters: -

- 1. Arbitration was refussed by parties.
- 2. Coach of PER 222123 brought a video and was showed at the hearing

Facts Found:

- 1. On a beat to windward, ARG210834 was sailing on starboard tack fetching the mark.
- PER222123 was close hauled on port tack on a converging course with ARG210834.
- 3. PER222123 reached the starboard layline at two boat lenghts of the mark, luffed and past head to wind.
- 4. Before PER222123 reached a closed hauled course, ARG210834 luffes and overlapes to windward of PER22123 from astern.
- 5. The minimum distance between the boats was of half a metre.

Conclusion & Rules:

1. After passing head to wind and before being on a close-hauled course, PER222123 failed to keep clear of ARG210834.PER222123 broke RRS 13
